EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING EXAMPLES

Work-based Learning can occur on or off-site and be paid or unpaid. Examples of work-based learning include an apprenticeship or internship, job shadowing, paid employment, school-based or school-sponsored enterprise, Supervised Agricultural Experience, Supervised Child Care Experience, and Health Occupations Clinical Experience.

Community-based and Service-based Learning can occur on or off-site and must be unpaid. This type of learning identifies a need within the community or school and structures a project to meet that need. These types of projects are carried out with public, non-profit agencies, civic, charitable and governmental organizations. Students have the opportunity to contribute to society and enhance their leadership skills.

Research-based Learning combines the academic skills of research and writing with hands-on learning in a real-world context. Students must have the prior approval of the Senior Project Review Committee. The project must produce a product or perform a service that demonstrates the application of the knowledge gained during the research conducted.

- BUSINESS CANNOT BE OWNED OR OPERATED BY AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER
- Hours must be completed at a LICENSED business or organization (not individuals).
- Hours must be completed OUTSIDE of the regular school day.
